



Ask Me About...




The children are now in their new classes Bluebell Class with Mrs Clampitt and Lavender Class with Miss Rowlands and Mrs Morrison.

Can you sort different objects into groups? For example, go on a nature walk and collect acorns and conkers. Can your child then sort them into a set of acorns and a set of conkers?
