This week we have had a few problems with children using mobile phones on school premises. Can I please remind you of our policy.

- Children in Year 6 can bring mobile phones to school. We believe that this is a sensible safety option for children who may be travelling home unsupervised after school.
- Children in other years are not allowed to bring mobile phones to school.
- Mobile phones are not allowed to be used in school. They must be turned off whilst children are on the school premises, this includes the playground.
- All mobile phones must be handed into the School Office at the start of the day.

What happens if a child uses their mobile phones in school?

1. If a child fails to follow the school policy, the mobile phone will be confiscated and placed in the school safe. This must be collected by an adult. The child will be given a warning and a reminder about school policy.
 2. If they fail to follow the policy for a second time, they will not be allowed to bring a mobile phone into school.
