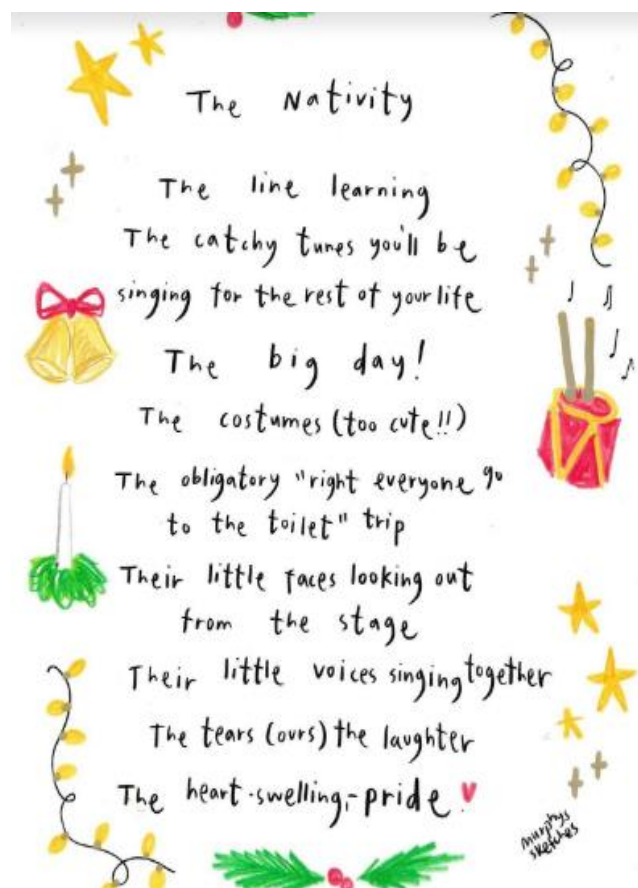
It is a busy festive week next week, here are some key dates for your diary...
